### **History Of Speed Judge**

Speed Judge was first envisioned back in 1999 when Tim Schilling the founder of RPI was planning an Annual convention for GM J-Body Platform Enthusiasts. Over the years the service grew from a simple access database to what it is today. It was created and tested at car shows for car shows. We truly believe this to be the best event management software and service in the field today. With over 6 years of experience and real life development, Speed Judge is for you!

### **What Speed Judge Is Today**

When first conceived, Speed Judge was nothing more than a registration database. Soon after, we began working on integrating electronic judging. After a few years of refining this, we have moved on to online registration, reporting, and soon to come even self check-in.



One question that we hear from potential clients time and time again is what happens if my data is lost or a computer decides to not work.

RPI is taken every precaution imaginable to insure this will not happen. Our server is run off a UPS (uninterrupted power supply) during the event, runs off a drive mirror, hourly backups, and many other precautions. Our name is on the line as well as yours the day of the show. And it will not fail, and we're put on word on that!

### ***Registration:***

Speed Judge is active in many different parts of registration. For most clients, we can import your online pre-registrations before the event to make for an easier check-in when the person arrives. Additionally, our system can even print labels for name cards as well as window cards for events with your entry and class numbers. All comes out automatically when the participants either checks in or registers.

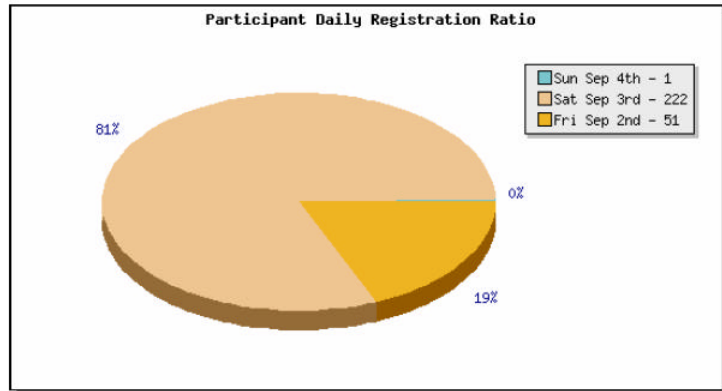
Our registration client has a simple and easy to use interface that can be loaded on any computer the client or we provide. We have kept our front-end client simple so that it can easily be used on multiple computers in an emergency with minimal effort. We can even tell you based on the participant's zip code who drove the fastest to the event.

### *Judging:*

Our service name is “Speed Judge” and up to this point you might be asking as to why. Our service uses PDAs (Personal Data Assistants) to collect judging scores. We have tested up to 3,000 score sheets before they will require a download. While this is certainly possible, our fault-tolerant nature suggests that we swap the PDA units after 50 to 100 scores to minimize the chance of any problems. While we are yet to have any, we always caution on the side of error. Once we have downloaded all the scores, we can have preliminary results in less than 5 minutes! Take that paper and calculators!

### *Reporting:*

There are many additional features to our service such as reporting. Sure, mailing lists are handy, but we can offer you so much more. For instance, we can supply real time statistics on your participants. Like the percentage of male to female participants, or the percentage for day of registrations compared to pre-registrations. My personal favorite is the percentage of attendees per state. At a glance you can track your events statistics throughout the day and we will even email these reports to you after the event for your records. Oh, and of course your mailing lists as well.



### *Data warehousing:*

A very important question for many of our clients is what happens to the participant data after the event. **The data is strictly the property of the event promoter!** We will warehouse the data for a period of one year as no additional fee so, at the request of the promoter, it can be restored to export information. This has been an absolute lifesaver for some of our clients that have lost files or emails that contained this information. Again, the data is the property of the event promoter and will not be shared for any reason.
